





Choral Scholarship – 2023/24

Background

Dulwich College (Singapore) has established an excellent reputation for developing the very finest musicians through its extensive choral, instrumental and orchestral ensembles. Choral scholarships are awards given to talented singers who wish to develop their choral singing while at Dulwich as a member of the College choirs.

Our Choral Scholars undergo a programme of tuition and coaching with specialist choral teachers to ensure that they are able to perform in various events, concerts and services at the College.

How the Scholarship will work

The 2023/24 Choral Scholarship can be applied for by any student who considers themselves to have the musical qualities, talent and skills required. The College will award one Junior and one Senior Choral scholarship each year. The scholarship will cover the cost of weekly private vocal tuition (30 minutes per week) during school term time.



How to apply?

If you are interested in becoming a Dulwich College (Singapore) Choral Scholar please send a motivated application and CV to the Director of Music.

If the initial application is successful, you will be contacted by the Director of Music to book a Musical Assessment and Interview.

The decision will be made by the Director of Music and the Head of College.
